AKC CANINE GOOD CITIZEN® TEST ITEMS	DESCRIPTION	PASS	NEEDS IMPROVE - MENT	COMMENTS
Item # 1 ACCEPT A FRIENDLY STRANGER	Judge and handler will shake hands and exchange pleasantries. Dog must show no sign of resentment or shyness, and must not break position.			
Item # 2 SIT POLITELY FOR PETTING	Dog either sits or stands by handler's side while judge approaches and begins to pet the dog on head and body only.			
Item # 3 APPEARANCE AND GROOMING	Judge will inspect dog, then combs or brushes dog, and lightly examines both ears and each front foot.			
Item # 4 OUT FOR A WALK	Dog can be on either side of handler, need not be perfectly aligned nor sit when stopped. Walk on loose leash doing left turn, right turn, about turn with two stops.			
Item # 5 WALK THROUGH A CROWD	Walk around and weave through at least 3 people showing some interest but under control. Not straining on leash.			
Item # 6 SIT and DOWN on COMMAND/STAYING in PLACE	Dog must respond to handler's command to 'sit' and 'down,' and remains in place when commanded.			
Item # 7 COME WHEN CALLED	Handler walks 10' from dog, turns to face dog, and calls dog.			
Item # 8 REACTION TO ANOTHER DOG	Person with neutral dog and handler with dog approach each other, shake hands & exchange pleasantries, and continue moving.			
Item # 9 REACTION TO DISTRACTIONS	Show dog has confidence when faced with distractions. May show interest and curiosity. May not bark, panic, show aggression. Distractions Used: (1) _____ (2) _____			
Item # 10 SUPERVISED SEPARATION	Judge holds dog on leash for 3 minutes with handler out of sight.			
Greeting Person in Wheelchair	Dog must correctly approach & sit or stand near person in wheelchair; small dogs may be placed on lap.			
Clumsy Petting	Dog must allow clumsy petting anywhere on body without showing fear, aggression, or panic.			
Angry Yelling	Handler and judge shout angrily at each other. Dog must not show fear, aggression, or panic.			
Bumping from Behind	Dog must allow being bumped from behind and not show fear, aggression, or panic.
