About Ohio Aquaculture

Aquaculture is growing in Ohio. In the 1998 Census of Aquaculture (COA), 33 farms reported \$1,788,000 in sales. In 2005, 55 farms reported \$3,185,000 in sales. This means we have a 67% increase in number of farms and a 78% increase in total sales over the seven year period. Many people feel that the census numbers actually underestimate aquaculture farms and sales in Ohio. I tend to agree as we had approximately 200 licensed farms in 2005, but only 55 farms reported. However, some data is better than no data, so let's look at where we stand.

According to the data, the majority of farms in Ohio are raising food fish. However, sport fish contribute the most to annual sales. While the number of baitfish farms has not grown since 1998, the sales have increased 53%. The growth in sales of ornamental fish is the largest for any of the fish types.

Close to one million dollars in food fish were sold from farms in Ohio. These four farms sold \$62,000 of hybrid striped bass (HSTB). That puts us sixth in the US in sales of HSTB as a food fish. Four farms in Ohio sold carp for food, ten catfish and four tilapia. Yellow perch accounted for the largest portion of food fish sales in Ohio with 25 farms selling \$222,000 of fish for an average price of \$3.12 per pound. While Wisconsin had more perch farms, Ohio ranks number one in sales of yellow perch for food in the US. As far as marketing is concerned, 35% of Ohio fish farms raising food fish retailed their product, 28% sell to a processor, 20% sell to fee and recreational fishing,

9% sell to wholesale distributors, live haulers or brokers and 7% sell direct to consumers.

Over one million dollars in sports fish were sold from 27 Ohio farms. Only Wisconsin had more farms with 33, and we are tied with Minnesota (27). Twenty farms in Ohio sold \$173,000 of largemouth bass. This puts us in fourth place in the US in terms of largemouth bass sold for sport. Three farms in Ohio sold smallmouth bass and six sold crappie. Twenty-two farms sold \$810,000 of bluegill ranking Ohio as the number one bluegill producing state in the country. Sport fish growers marketed 31% of their product to fee and recreational fishing, 5% direct to consumers and 1% to processors.

Twelve farms in Ohio sold \$827,000 worth of baitfish raised in 98 total acres of water. This puts us in fifth place behind Arkansas, Minnesota, New York and Wisconsin in terms of number of farms and fourth in sales. Nine farms raised fathead minnows while three raised feeder goldfish, and three raised golden shiners. Twenty-one percent of baitfish sales were to wholesale distributors, live haulers, etc. Ohio had 18 farms that sold \$326,000 worth of ornamental fish. Twelve farms sold goldfish, 15 sold koi carp, and one sold tropical fish. Twenty percent of ornamental fish were marketed directly to consumers while 3% were sold retail. Seven farms in Ohio, all selling freshwater prawns, sold \$55,000 worth of crustaceans. Forty-six percent of the product was sold direct to consumers.

The 2005 COA also reported that there were 759

acres of water used for aquaculture in Ohio, up 65% from 1998. Of these, 8 farms leased 151 acres of water. Forty percent of Ohio farms used groundwater, 75% used on-farm surface water, and 4% used off farm water. Farmers reported a total of 576 ponds with an average size of 1.2 acres for 671 total acres of ponds. Nine farms reported 48 raceways with an average flow of 174 gallons/minute. Fifteen farms used recirculating aquaculture with 158 tanks holding 431,150 gallons of water. Six farms used another 174 tanks that don't recirculate for an additional 173,010 gallons. There were five farms using 52 cages with 4,212 cu. ft. of rearing space.

Of the 55 farms reporting in Ohio, 36 had a total of 86 unpaid workers. Six farms had 29 full-time workers and 18 farms had 46 part-time workers. The 21 farms reporting paid workers had an annual payroll of \$935,000.
