

#### **Wilmington Delaware Pawpaw Festival**

Wilmington, Delaware holds a Pawpaw Folk Festival each August. This is the first year NAPGA was invited to have a display and provide educational publications.

It was sponsored by Delaware State Parks, Division of Parks and Recreation. It was held on grounds of Alapocas Run State Park Blue Ball

Barn on Saturday, August 20, 2016.

There were about 15 booths of various types, several food truck vendors, a booth selling pawpaw plants, and a local radio station was broadcasting from the grounds. Many were interested in learning about pawpaws and some were enthusiastic enough to become NAPGA members.

Kentucky State University hosted the conference September 1-3, 2016 in Frankfort, Ky. It began with a tour England's Orchard in Mckee, KY. There was a light drizzle part of the day but not enough
